

Frontline Leadership

Length: 1 Day

Summary: Frontline leaders are first line leaders who supervise a group of followers to achieve the operational-level strategies of the organizations. These could be managers, project leaders, departmental heads, supervisors, foreman, etc. whose job includes supervising a group of followers to execute the daily running of the organization's operations.

After completing this course, students will know how to:

- Understand the roles and traits of a frontline leader and how to communicate effectively. Identify the skills required for frontline leadership and conflict resolution.
- Understand the factors affecting the workplace culture and the challenges for frontline leadership. Understand the styles of frontline leadership, guidelines to promote a positive atmosphere and ways to address negative attitudes.
